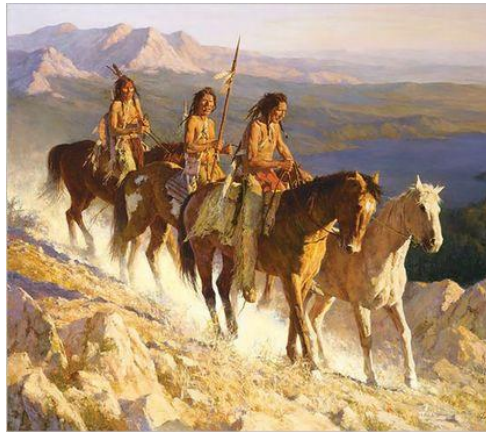

The Booth's permanent collection covers more than a dozen galleries, showcasing legendary artists such as George Catlin, Albert Bierstadt, Frederic Remington, W.R. Leigh, Charles Russell, Ansel Adams and others.

However, the core of the collection is built around living masters of traditional Western imagery such as Howard Terpning, Ken Riley, G. Harvey and many OPA members plus more contemporary stylized works.

The Booth Western Art Museum is now the largest permanent exhibition space for Western art in the country. The museum is an architectural wonder – designed to resemble a modern pueblo and constructed from Bulgarian limestone.
