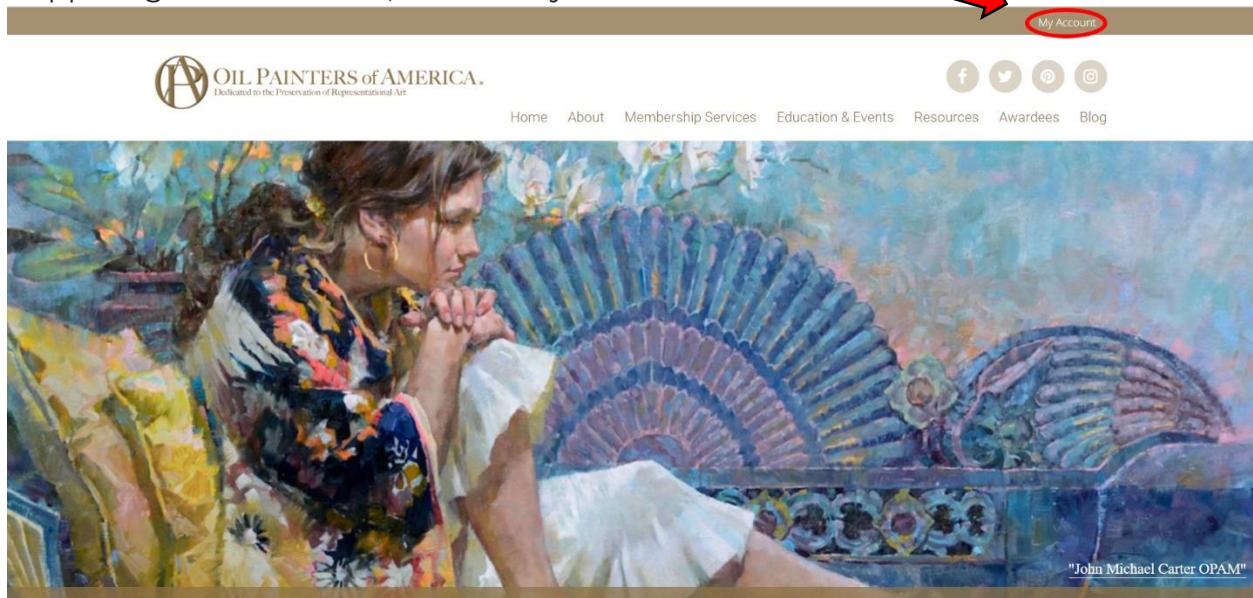
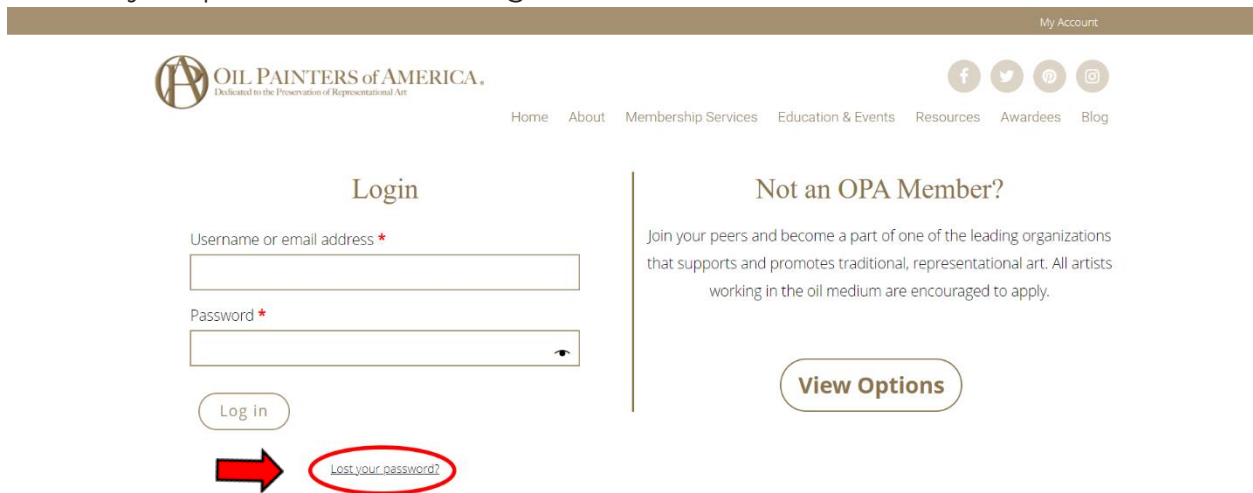


# Reset OPA Password and Login Instructions

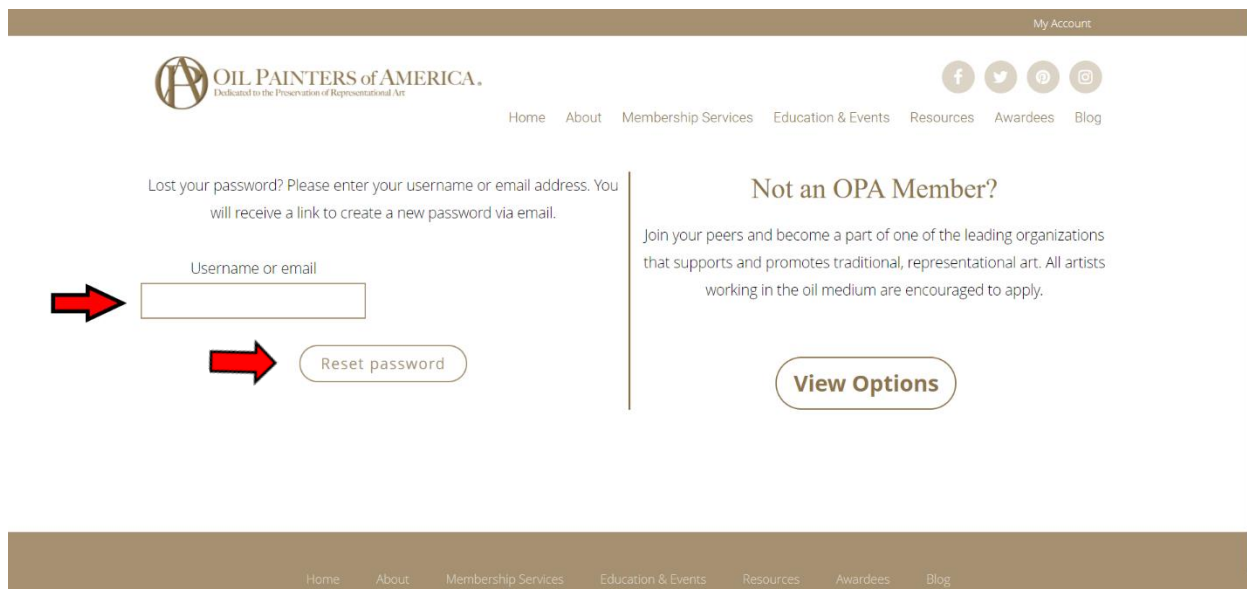
1. Visit [www.oilpaintersofamerica.com](http://www.oilpaintersofamerica.com)
2. In the upper right-hand corner, click on My Account




3. Click on Lost your password? on the Login side.



4. Enter your email address that you have used for your OPA account and click *Reset password*




5. You will receive an email with a link to reset your password. This may take several minutes





7. Enter your new password in the box provided - it must be at least 12 characters in length.

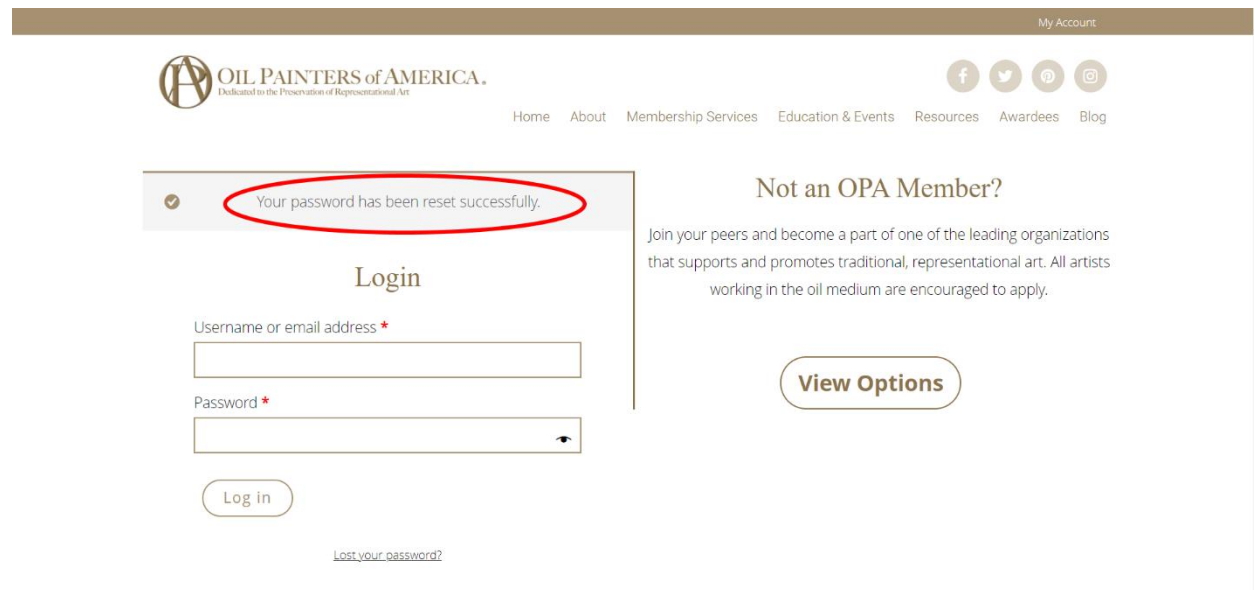
