She has been a go-to harmony vocal singer and arranger for dozens of artists' albums, including Eliza Gilkyson, James McMurtry, Robert Harrison, Jaimee Harris, Bonnie Whitmore, Graham Weber, and many others.

Pre-pandemic, BettySoo toured solo, as a member of Nobody's Girl, and with Bonnie Whitmore. Live-streaming, BettySoo cuts a unique path: establishing authentic connection and encouraging compassion. Her weekly Nobody's Happy Hour show, which features a new guest each Tuesday evening, is well worth tuning into – it's a unique blend of a songwriters' round and a game show! In 2022, she will kick off the year touring nationally in support of James McMurtry.

### Painting Demonstration with Charlie Hunter

Location: The Steamboat Grand - Korbel Ballroom

Charlie Hunter is a nationally recognized painter of the post-pastoral American landscape. His distinctive, low-chroma work, heavily reliant on a mastery of values, edges, and composition, utilizes a variety of moderately unorthodox techniques; manipulating paint with a window washer's squeegee or impressing the pattern of paper towels into a painted surface to evoke halftone screens of lithographic reproduction.

Growing up in rural New England, the son of a small-town printer, Hunter's work examines the pressures of modern urban and suburban culture upon small-town and agricultural community, simultaneously celebrating "what

nature does to what man creates." Initially a graphic designer of tour posters for musicians such as the Jerry Garcia Band, Bob Dylan, The Clash, Eurythmics and REM, Hunter became a music manager and event producer, before turning to painting full time in the 2000's.

His work has been featured in numerous art and lifestyle publications, is in multiple collections and museums, and was the recent subject of a one-man show, SEMAPHORE, at the Brattleboro (VT) Museum, curated by fellow artist Eric Aho. With painter and designer Larry Moore, Hunter created the En Train Air painting train in 2019, a concept they hope to revive post-pandemic. Hunter's weekly live stream, REASONABLY FINE ART TALKS, has a fervent following.

"Monet's Influence on American Impressionism" with Best Selling Author Ross King

Location: The Steamboat Grand - Korbel Ballroom

Ross King is the bestselling author of books on Italian, French and Canadian art and history. Among his books are Brunelleschi's Dome (2000), Michelangelo and the Pope's Ceiling (2002), The Judgment of Paris (Governor General's Award, 2006), Leonardo and The Last Supper (Governor General's Award, 2012), and Mad Enchantment: Claude Monet and the Painting of the Water Lilies (Charles Taylor Prize, 2017). He has also published two novels (Domino and Ex-Libris), a biography of Niccolò Machiavelli, and a collection of Leonardo da Vinci's fables, jokes and riddles. He is the co-author with Anja Grebe of Florence: The Paintings & Frescoes, 1250-1743 (2015), the most comprehensive book ever undertaken on the art of Florence. Ross's newest book, the subject of four years of research and writing, marks his return to the 'Golden Age' of

fifteenth-century Florence. The Bookseller of Florence tells the remarkable true story of one of the unsung heroes of the Italian Renaissance: the manuscript dealer Vespasiano da Bisticci, known as 'the king of the world's booksellers'. In tandem with his writing, Ross is an active fundraiser for the arts and a passionate lecturer and tour guide. He has lectured in many American museums, including at the Art Institute of Chicago, the Frick Collection, and the National Gallery.



Painting Demonstration by Juror of Awards Johanna Harmon OPAM Moderated by Suzie Baker OPA

Johanna Harmon was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, but spent most of her childhood in Tempe, Arizona. Johanna began designing and recording visual observations at the age of seven, but it wasn't until almost two decades later that she was introduced to the traditional language of art at the Scottsdale Artists' School in Arizona, the Fechin Art Institute in Taos, New Mexico, and the Art Students League of Denver in Colorado. There, she studied painting alongside prominent portrait and figure artists with varied artistic philosophies and approaches such as Carolyn

Anderson, John Asaro, Mark Daily, Daniel Gerhartz OPAM, Quang Ho OPAM and C.W. Mundy OPAM. Later, she went on to expand her understanding further by studying contemporary realism with Daniel Sprick, and abstract realism with David A. Leffel OPAM and Sherrie McGraw OPAM. In 2013, Harmon received OPA Signature Member designation, and acceptance into OPA's 22nd National Juried Exhibition where she received her second Gold Medal Award, becoming the first artist to receive two in the organization's history. Her first Gold Medal was awarded in 2007. Her work has been published in *American Art Collector, International Artist, Fine Art Connoisseur, Southwest Art, Artbook of the New West*, and *Focus Santa Fe* and is collected internationally.

Over the past ten years, he has been honored to have been selected by the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library Foundation to paint portraits for the recipients of the Lincoln Leadership Prize, these portraits include President Bill Clinton, Steven Spielberg, "The Little Rock Nine," Doris Kearns Goodwin, Neil deGrasse Tyson and Prime Minister Tony Blair.

To Raj, the design of a painting is paramount, and he tries to find something beautiful, simple and clear in the composition and then build in layers upon layers of complexity. He is passionate about teaching art and is on the faculty at the Art Students League of Denver and on Made for Artists. He also teaches in his studio at rajchaudhuri.com. His work can be seen at Saks Galleries, Denver, Colorado and Jack Meier Gallery, Houston, Texas.

Inspired by her grandfather, Anna Rose Bain OPA spent her free time as a child sketching from nature and poring over art books. She studied fine art at Hillsdale College from 2003-2007 and was the first student in the school's history to have a solo senior show. Prior to graduating, she spent the summer at the famed Florence Academy of Art where she studied figure painting. After college, Anna continued her education by studying with several renowned artists including Judith Carducci, Clayton J. Beck, III, Nancy Guzik, and more. Anna now resides in Arvada, CO with her husband Steve and their two children. She

works full-time as a fine art oil painter and commissioned portrait artist. Her award-winning work can be found in numerous private and public collections around the world.



John Taft OPA

John Taft OPA studied design and art at Rochester Institute of Technology, and then at Art Center College of Design in Pasadena, California. He eventually landed in NYC as a Designer and Art Director for several design groups and television networks. Living in New York City was exciting and provided John with unending opportunities to visit all the great art museums and galleries the city had to offer. When he became a "hands off" Design Director in 2001, he decided it was time to get "hands on" and began painting when he could find time between work and a growing family. After the tragedy of September 11, John gathered regularly with other artists to engage in discussions of art, faith, and purpose. It was during this time that John decided he would pursue oil painting full time. When an opportunity presented itself in 2004, he moved west with

his family to begin painting in earnest. His work has since received several awards and honors including the Gold Medal at OPA's 2021 Western Regional Exhibition and "Best Signature Award of Excellence" at OPA's 2018 National Exhibition.



Jane Hunt OPA

After moving to the US from England as a teenager, Jane Hunt OPA received her BFA in illustration from the Cleveland Institute of Art. She is a Master Signature Member of PAPNM and WAOW, a Signature Member of OPA, AIS, LPAPA, AWA, WAOW, PAAC, and an artist member of the Salmagundi Club. Hunt was recently ranked among the fifteen most awarded artists in the US. The artist's works have won over 200 awards and hold the distinction of receiving the most annual Oil Painters of America awards (5 in 2018) as well as the record number of annual Plein Air Salon wins (8 in 2020). Jane Hunt is represented by notable galleries in the US as well as her native England. She's lived in Colorado for the past twenty-five years, where she continues to be awed and inspired by the beauty surrounding her.


