# PARKING INFORMATION FOR DOWNTOWN CHARLESTON

**Short-stay parking in downtown Charleston:** The main options for short-term parking in downtown Charleston are metered street parking or garages. However, most street parking is limited to 2 hours. All street meters require payment from Monday through Saturday, 9am to 6pm. It's also worth noting that street parking downtown south of Broad Street requires residential parking permits, so be sure not to park in these areas as you will likely get a ticket. There are several car parks and covered garages in downtown offering short-term parking. These garages accept cash or credit card, and some are staffed 24/7.
