National Exhibition Catalog

Every year OPA members will receive a beautiful color catalog featuring the paintings being exhibited in the National Juried Exhibition. This catalog features a picture of each painting, as well as a list of all exhibitors and current members.

Scholarships

Oil Painters of America offers six scholarships a year. Four \$500 scholarships appropriately named after OPA's founding member, Shirl Smithson. The Shirl Smithson Memorial Scholarships are open to all current Associate members. One scholarship is designated specifically for a student member who is currently enrolled as a full-time student.

The Susanna Aitchison MacSporran Memorial Scholarship is for artists with a strong desire to pursue or continue a career in portraiture painting. The recipient will receive a \$500 scholarship to further their artistic education.

The Betty Schmidt Memorial Scholarship was established by OPA's Board of Directors to honor her long-time commitment to OPA. This \$500 scholarship is for artists who are age 55 and older and are in their early developmental stages of their painting career.

Membership Types

Student members are individuals who are ages 14 – 23 and have interests in representational oil painting. They receive the same benefits as an associate member, except they do not have the right to vote or to hold office.

Associate members are artists who paint in oils in the representational style who reside in North America. *All members begin as an Associate.*

Signature members (OPA) are artists who consistently demonstrate high quality work. There are two ways to become eligible:

Option 1: Automatic Signature Status

Within an eight year period, a member must have exhibited in either 1.) four national OPA shows; OR 2.) three national OPA shows and three regional or salon shows. (Regional and Salon shows must be within the last five years.) If these requirements are met, Signature Member status will be conferred with no further evaluation. However, qualified members must still submit an application between June 1 and October 15 for approval at the December board meeting.

Option 2: Committee Review

Over an indefinite period of time, members must have exhibited in 1.) three national OPA shows; OR 2.) two national OPA shows and three OPA regional or salon shows. (Regional and salon shows must be within the last five years.) Members who have met these requirements are qualified to submit for Signature status between June 1 and October 15 for consideration at the December board meeting.

Master Signature members (OPAM) are artists who have exhibited exceptional merit in their work and accomplishment in the field of art. Signature members may apply before September 1 for review and approval by the OPA Board of Directors.

Collectors' Circle Members are a community of art lovers and collectors interested in meeting like-minded people who share their enthusiasm for the arts and desire to support artists.

International Supporters are artists living abroad who do not meet the residence requirements. These member artists receive membership benefits but are not eligible to apply for any regional or national exhibitions.

Gallery members are galleries who represent at least 1 OPA member's work at all times.
