


First Place: \$500 cash/\$500 Blick Gift Certificate





Paintings must be created in oils in the representational style. This includes a broad spectrum of styles ranging from realistic to impressionist or your own style, as long as it is representational. Both plein air and/or studio work are acceptable. All submissions will be displayed online with the artist's name, painting title & size, school name and age on OPA's website. All entries must depict family-friendly subject matter (any portrayals of graphic nudity, violence, or other non-family-friendly subject matter will not be accepted).

The top three award winners in each division will be invited to exhibit their work in conjunction with OPA's 33rd National Exhibition of Traditional Oils to be held at Mark Arts in Wichita, KS, April 3 – May 31, 2024.

Note, winners who elect to exhibit their artwork will be responsible for shipping to and from the exhibition. All paintings must be framed and wired for hanging.

Student submissions will be accepted online through OPA's website from November 1 through February 2, 2024. Winners will be notified of the competition results directly by mid-February.
