Aimee Erickson OPA is an internationally renowned oil painter and instructor celebrated for her engaging style and versatility in subject matter. She has delivered lectures and demonstrations at venues across the nation and abroad. A standout in plein air painting competitions, Erickson has received Best of Show and Artists' Choice at Plein Air Easton and Best of Show at various art festivals such as those in Carmel, Sonoma, Olmsted, Laguna, and the Pacific Northwest.

She has been recognized as a finalist by the Portrait Society of America and won Best of Show at an American Women Artists national exhibition. Erickson is also a Signature Member of Oil Painters of America, where she has received multiple accolades. Furthermore, she has participated in international plein air groups in China and Russia, was an inaugural member of Charlie Hunter's En Train Air expedition, and painted the official portrait of Oregon's Governor Barbara Roberts in 1997. In 2023, she released her first book, *Plein Air Techniques for Artists: Principles and Methods for Painting in Natural Light*, which is widely available. As she expresses, "Color has emotional weight and is related to the shape of space. Drawing or painting, for me, means to look at the thing and transmit its vitality to the canvas."
